HISTORICAL CONTEXT AND LITERARY BACKGROUND

EMILY DICKINSON'S LIFE AND WRITING ENVIRONMENT

SHE WROTE NEARLY 1,800 POEMS, OFTEN COMPOSING THEM ON SMALL SCRAPS OF PAPER, WHICH WERE LATER ASSEMBLED INTO FASCICLES. DICKINSON'S PERSONAL EXPERIENCES, INCLUDING HER RELATIONSHIPS WITH FAMILY AND FRIENDS, AS WELL AS HER REFLECTIONS ON MORTALITY AND SPIRITUALITY, HEAVILY INFLUENCED THE THEMES PRESENT IN HER SELECTED POEMS.

PUBLICATION HISTORY OF DICKINSON'S POEMS

THE SELECTED POEMS OF EMILY DICKINSON WERE FIRST PUBLISHED AFTER HER DEATH IN 1886, OFTEN HEAVILY EDITED TO CONFORM TO 19TH-CENTURY POETIC NORMS.
