UNDERSTANDING MERCY AS A RHETORICAL THEME

APPEALS TO AUTHORITY AND MORALITY

ETHICAL APPEALS FREQUENTLY INVOKE RELIGIOUS DOCTRINES, LEGAL PRINCIPLES, OR CULTURAL TRADITIONS THAT UPHOLD MERCY AS A FUNDAMENTAL VALUE. THESE REFERENCES ESTABLISH CREDIBILITY AND MORAL AUTHORITY, REINFORCING THE LEGITIMACY OF MERCY AS AN ARGUMENT.

ETHOS, PATHOS, AND LOGOS IN MERCY RHETORIC

PATHOS: ENGAGING EMOTIONS TO ADVOCATE MERCY

MERCY RHETORIC FREQUENTLY TARGETS THE AUDIENCE'S EMOTIONS BY HIGHLIGHTING HUMAN VULNERABILITY AND THE CONSEQUENCES OF HARSH JUDGMENT. EMOTIONAL ENGAGEMENT MOTIVATES AUDIENCES TO EMBRACE MERCY AS A PREFERABLE ALTERNATIVE TO PUNISHMENT OR INDIFFERENCE.

LOGOS: LOGICAL ARGUMENTS SUPPORTING MERCY

LOGICAL REASONING IS EMPLOYED TO SHOW THE PRACTICAL BENEFITS OF MERCY, SUCH AS SOCIAL HARMONY, REHABILITATION, AND ETHICAL CONSISTENCY. BY PRESENTING CLEAR EVIDENCE AND RATIONAL ARGUMENTS, RHETORICIANS DEMONSTRATE THAT MERCY IS NOT ONLY MORALLY DESIRABLE BUT ALSO LOGICALLY SOUND.

CONTEXTUAL INFLUENCES ON MERCY RHETORICAL APPEALS
