DRAGAN

DRAGAN, THE BAKER, REPRESENTS THE EVERYDAY PERSON TRYING TO MAINTAIN A SEMBLANCE OF NORMALCY AMIDST CHAOS. HIS CHARACTER IS A REMINDER OF THE IMPORTANCE OF COMMUNITY AND CONNECTION, AS HE NAVIGATES THE CHALLENGES OF SURVIVAL WHILE LONGING FOR THE DAYS BEFORE THE WAR.

WRITING STYLE AND STRUCTURE

STEVEN GALLOWAY EMPLOYS A LYRICAL AND EVOCATIVE WRITING STYLE THROUGHOUT *THE CELLIST OF SARAJEVO*. THE NARRATIVE IS RICH WITH IMAGERY, CAPTURING THE STARK CONTRASTS OF BEAUTY AND BRUTALITY.
