REINFORCING EXISTING PATTERNS OF SEGREGATION RATHER THAN ALLEVIATING THEM.

UNDERSTANDING SEGREGATION POLICIES

ZONING LAWS

- THESE LAWS REINFORCED THE IDEA THAT CERTAIN NEIGHBORHOODS WERE "EXCLUSIVE" AND MAINTAINED PROPERTY VALUES BY KEEPING OUT LOWER-INCOME RESIDENTS.

URBAN RENEWAL PROJECTS

- URBAN RENEWAL INITIATIVES OFTEN TARGETED PREDOMINANTLY BLACK NEIGHBORHOODS FOR DEMOLITION, DISPLACING RESIDENTS WITHOUT OFFERING ADEQUATE COMPENSATION OR RELOCATION ASSISTANCE.
- THESE PROJECTS WERE FRAMED AS EFFORTS TO IMPROVE CITIES BUT RESULTED IN THE DESTRUCTION OF ESTABLISHED COMMUNITIES.

THE ROLE OF THE COURTS
