WPA IN THE MIDWEST

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENTS

INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS WERE THE BACKBONE OF WPA EFFORTS, INCLUDING HIGHWAYS, BRIDGES, DAMS, AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS. THESE PROJECTS NOT ONLY PROVIDED IMMEDIATE EMPLOYMENT BUT LAID THE FOUNDATION FOR LONG-TERM ECONOMIC GROWTH WITHIN STATES.

CULTURAL AND ARTISTIC PROJECTS

THE WPA'S FEDERAL PROJECT NUMBER ONE FUNDED ARTISTS, WRITERS, MUSICIANS, AND ACTORS, RESULTING IN A RICH CULTURAL LEGACY. MURALS, THEATER PRODUCTIONS, AND ORAL HISTORIES FROM THIS PERIOD REMAIN SIGNIFICANT STATE CULTURAL ASSETS.
